The Government of Mozambique has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the **Digital Governance and Economy Project - EDGE**, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services ("the Services") include:

- Prepare the description of tasks based on the profiles required for INAGE, IP;
- Propose remuneration and social benefits for each position, taking into account the needs of INAGE, IP;
- Present, whenever requested and for each available position, 3 proposals for technicians and respective CVs;
- Identify and allocate technicians to INAGE, IP within the deadline agreed for each case.

Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are: (i) At least 2 successful experiences in carrying out similar activities; (ii) Proven and successful experience of 3 years in

the recruitment and management of Human Resources in the area of Information and Communication Technologies; and (iii) Proven knowledge of Mozambique's Labor Laws. Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" September 2023 ("Procurement Regulations"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Procurement Regulations.
